## 3. Proposed Financial Transfer

Old Parent Advisory Council (P.A.C.) held bank account used for hot lunch, Spirit Days and fundraisers. Karla Hancar proposed two possible scenarios for P.A.C. bank account:

- a) Go to bank and open a new account for Parent Enrichment Association Committed to Education (P.E.A.C.E.) then transfer remaining P.A.C. balance to new P.E.A.C.E. account.
- b) Change P.A.C. account name to P.E.A.C.E and order new cheques in said name.

Sherrill Gering made a notion that St. Benedict Parent Advisory Council (P.A.C.) be changed to Parent Enrichment Association Committed to Education (P.E.A.C.E.). - Suggested to have classes "compete" against each other for Sports Day.
- "Fresh Fruit" Monday: have basket with fruit for kids. Jolyne will look into Breakfast For Lunch program with Leduc & District Food Bank.

- Lindsay will contact City of Leduc to see about basketball nets to be put in hockey rink.
